Pursuant to Article 1021 paragraph 3 indent 5 of the Maritime Code ("Official Gazette" No. 181/04 and 76/07), the Minister of Sea, Transport and Infrastructure hereby issues the following

ORDINANCE

ON AMENDMENTS TO THE ORDINANCE ON THE TERMS AND METHODS OF MAINTAINING ORDER IN PORTS AND OTHER PARTS OF INTERNAL WATERS AND TERRITORIAL SEA OF THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA

Article 1

In Article 2 paragraph 1 of the Ordinance on the Terms and Methods of Maintaining Order in Ports and Other Parts of Internal Waters and Territorial Sea of the Republic of Croatia ("Official Gazette" No. 90/2005 and 10/2008), after point 7, points 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 are added to read as follows:

"8. *IMO FAL Convention* is the 1965 IMO Convention on Facilitation of International Maritime Traffic, as amended;

9. *IMO FAL forms* are standardised IMO FAL Forms 1 - 6 in A-4 format as stipulated in the IMO FAL Convention;

10. *ship's stores* means goods for use in the ship, including consumable goods, goods carried for sale to passengers and crew members, fuel and lubricants, but excluding ship's equipment and spare parts;

11. *ship's equipment* means articles other than ship's spare parts which are on board a ship for use thereon and are removable but not of a consumable nature, including accessories, such as lifeboats, life-saving devices, furniture, ship's apparel and similar items;

12. *ship's spare parts* means articles of a repair or replacement nature for incorporation into the ship in which they are carried

13. *crew's effects* means clothing, items in everyday use and other articles, which may include currency belonging to the crew and carried on the ship."

Article 2

In Article 40 paragraph 1, after the words: "passenger list", comma is added and followed by the words: "a declaration of the ship's stores and a declaration of crew's effects,".

In paragraph 6, after the words: "crew list", a comma is added and the conjunction: "and" is deleted, and after the words: "passenger list" the following words are added: "a declaration of the ship's stores and a declaration of crew's effects".

Article 3

In Article 42, after the words: "cargo", the following words are added: "a declaration of the ship's stores and a declaration of crew's effects."

Article 4

In Article 80b paragraph 1, after the words: "the Republic of Croatia", the following words are added: "or navigate in innocent passage"

Article 5

Annex 2 is amended to read:

"Automatic Identification System (AIS) must be installed:

- on the day of entry into force of this Ordinance:
- on passenger ships of 150 gross tonnage and more in international service;
- on cargo ships of 300 gross tonnage and more in international service;
- high-speed craft of 150 gross tonnage and more built under the DSC Code, 1994 HSC Code and 2000 HSC Code;
- high-speed passenger ships of 150 gross tonnage less regardless of the code they were built under which perform regular line service.
- as of the date of the first regular inspection after 1 January 2009:
 - on passenger ships of 300 gross tonnage and more sailing in the navigation areas 5, 6, 7 and 8;
 - on cargo ships of gross tonnage 300 and more sailing in the navigation areas 5, 6, 7 and 8.
- on the day of accession of the Republic of Croatia to the European Union:
- all passenger ships regardless of their gross tonnage in international service.

Article 6

This Ordinance shall enter into force on the eighth day after the day of its publication in the "Official Gazette".
